Bursary Program

Eligibility

- All current Balmoral Hall School (BH) students and new applicants, entering Grades 1 to 12, may request financial assistance in the form of a Bursary.
- In order to be considered for a Bursary, students must either be currently registered or have submitted an application to attend the School for the upcoming school year.
- Bursaries are awarded based primarily upon financial need.

Procedure

- Balmoral Hall School will be working with Apple Financial Services for the 2008/2009 school year.
- All parents of students wishing to be considered for a Bursary must complete a FACS PFS (Financial Aid for Students Attending Canadian Schools – Parents’ Financial Statement.)
- Information and PFS forms can be requested from the BH Admissions office, and are also available from the BH front office or on the BH website at www.balmoralhall.com .
- The completed PFS form, fees and copies of the required financial documentation **must be mailed directly to Apple Financial Services, 200 Burndale Avenue, North York, Ontario, M2N 1T3.**
- Notification of the provision of Bursaries:
 - Returning Students - will accompany the re-registration information.
 - New Students - will be sent out dependent upon the date the PFS form was submitted to Apple Financial Services. Bursaries take approximately 3-4 weeks to process.

Families who submit late PFS forms will be given consideration according to availability of funds.

Bursary Information

- The final decision regarding Bursaries is made by the Financial Aid Committee at Balmoral Hall School. All information and decisions are kept strictly confidential.
- It is Balmoral Hall School’s policy that no more than 50% of a student’s fees will be covered by combined Bursaries and Scholarships. The Bursary Program is meant to supplement, not to replace, a family’s financial commitment. Actual amounts awarded vary according to a number of factors including the number of requests received in any one year, and to the financial resources available.
- Bursaries are granted for one year only and must be reapplied for each year.
- Bursaries are awarded by the School and carry no obligation of repayment, although it is hoped that beneficiaries will, in the future, become donors to Annual Fund.
- For income tax purposes, the School will issue a T4-A for the current tax year.
- The full amount of the Bursary will appear on the monthly statement according to chosen Plan options (e.g.: Plan A – June, 2008, Plan B – September, 2008, Plan C – December, 2008)

If, for any reason, a student leaves the School during an academic year, any allocated Bursary funds must be paid back or revert back to the School.
